Christopher J. Sullivan, Ph.D. is Professor and Director of Graduate Studies in the School of Criminal Justice at the University of Cincinnati. His main areas of focus include developmental criminology; crime and delinquency prevention research; and research methodology and analytic methods. He has published numerous peer-reviewed articles and invited book chapters on these and other topics in journals such as the *Journal of Quantitative Criminology*, *Justice Quarterly*, *Criminology*, and *Criminology & Public Policy*. He is currently Co-Editor of the *Journal of Research in Crime and Delinquency*. Professor Sullivan has served as Data Analyst or Principal Investigator on several state or federally-funded studies dating back to 2000. Since 2010, his research on Juvenile Delinquency and Justice Policy and Practice has been funded by the National Institute of Justice (NIJ), the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP), and State of Ohio, Department of Youth Services (DYS).
